## Tentative Itinerary

### **Day 1: Arrival**

Depart in the morning for the Miami area. Afternoon tram tour through Everglades National Park. Guided ranger program through the Shark Valley where the group will learn about the unique hydrology and ecology of the largest subtropical wetland ecosystem in North America. Also see plenty of alligators and birds in the natural glades environment. Overnight Key Largo.

### **Day 2: Diving at Aquarius Reef Base, Key Largo**

Aquarius Reef Base is an underwater laboratory in the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary. It is one of the few underwater research facilities in the world dedicated to science. Overnight Key Largo.

### **Day 3: Marine Lab Sea grass and Coral Reef Study**

Today we participate in a fun and informative two part program on the Florida bay sea grass/mangrove ecosystems and coral reefs. Two snorkeling adventures—one into the sea grass beds and another to the coral reefs.

### **Day 4: Key West and the Sea Turtle Hospital**

Visit *The Turtle Hospital* for a fun and informative program about Sea Turtle Biology and how dedicated volunteers help the turtles recover from both human and natural impacts. Later, travel to Key West. Visit Ernest Hemingway's home, shop, dinner and watch the sunset from the southern tip of the continental U.S. Return to Islamorada.

### **Day 5: Kayaking and Beach Time**

This morning we get some down time to go kayaking in Florida bay or hang out on the beach before departing for Miami and our flight home.
